RESOLUTION MOUNTAIN VISTA METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 2

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES, ADOPTING A BUDGET, AND APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE FUNDS AND IN THE AMOUNTS SET FORTH HEREIN FOR THE MOUNTAIN VISTA METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 2 (THE "DISTRICT"), EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2024 AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2024 AND AMENDING THE 2023 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District has authorized its consultants to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said governing body at the proper time;

WHEREAS, the proposed budget has been submitted to the Board of Directors of the District for its consideration;

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published or posted in accordance with the law, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at a designated place, a public hearing was held on November 2, 2023 and interested electors were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF MOUNTAIN VISTA METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 2, EL PASO COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO:

Section 1. <u>Budget Revenues.</u> That the estimated revenues for each fund as more specifically set out in the budget attached hereto are accepted and approved. Revenue reflected in the budget from the Developer, in the form of Developer Advances, has been approximated and shall be collected in amounts sufficient to meet the needs of the District of expenditures without excess. Section 2. <u>Budget Expenditures.</u> That estimated expenditures for each fund as more specifically set out in the budget attached hereto are accepted and approved.

Section 3. Adoption of Budget. That the budget as submitted and attached and incorporated herein by this reference, and if amended, then as amended, is hereby approved and adopted as the budget of District for the year stated above and the amended budget for 2023 is approved.

Section 4. <u>Levy of General Property Taxes.</u> That the foregoing budget indicated that the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Contractual Obligations is \$4,535. That the foregoing budget indicated that the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Operations and Maintenance is \$1,512. That the valuation for assessment, as certified by the El Paso County Assessor, is \$151,160.

Section 5.

of the District for the budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 30.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District. That for the purposes of meeting all expenses of operations and maintenance of the District for the budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 10.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District.

Section 6.

Board finds that the foregoing budget and mill levies do not result in a violation of any applicable property tax or fiscal year spending limitation.

Section 7. <u>Certification</u>. The District's agents are hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of El Paso County, Colorado, the mill levies for the District hereinabove determined and set.

Section 8. <u>Appropriations.</u> That the amounts set forth as expenditures and balances remaining, as specifically allocated in the budget attached hereto, are hereby appropriated from the revenues of each fund, to each fund, for the purposes stated and no other.

The attached 2024 Budget for Mountain Vista Metropolitan District No. 2 includes these important features:

- The primary sources of revenue for the district are tax revenues and fees.
- Payment of debt service obligations.

The Budgetary basis of accounting timing measurement method used is:

The District uses funds to budget and report on the financial position and results of operations. Fund accounting is designed to demonstrate legal compliance and to aid financial management by segregating transactions related to certain governmental functions. The various funds determine the total District budget. All of the district's funds are considered Governmental Funds and are reported using the current financial resources and the modified accrual basis of accounting. Revenues are recognized when they are measurable and available. Revenues are considered available when they are collectible within the current period. For this purpose, the District considers revenues to be available if they are collected within 60 days of the end of the current fiscal period. Expenditures, other than the interest on long term obligations, are recorded when the liability is incurred or the long-term obligation is paid.

The services to be provided/ delivered during the budget year are the following:

- Contracted legal and management services including state required reporting, financial and accounting reports, billing and other services.
- Facilitate repayment of debt for the District.
